# Background

Car Free Day is an internationally recognized event which started in Europe in 2000 as a day for residents to leave their cars at home, and instead get around by cleaner and more sustainable methods of travel for both commute and non-commute purposes. Travel modes include public transportation, bicycling, walking, and scootering.

In the Washington, DC region, Car Free Day began in 2008 and falls under the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board's (TPB) Commuter Connections program, at the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments (COG). The Commuter Connections program is funded by the District of Columbia, Maryland, Virginia, and U.S. Departments of Transportation. Commuter Connections organizes the annual event, along with its network partners, made up of local governments within the region. Car Free Day in the National Capital region also includes the option to participate by traveling "car lite" (carpool or vanpool) and also teleworking.

A regional marketing campaign promoted the Car Free Day event held on September 22, 2023, which helped to yield 5,105 pledges, a 26 percent increase over the previous year.

Three main objectives of the Car Free Day marketing campaign were to:

- 1. Use the event as an opportunity to promote alternative modes of transportation for both commute and non-commute trips.
- 2. Encourage commuters and the general public to take the online pledge to use car free or carlite travel methods on Car Free Day.
- 3. Measure and report impacts, as part of the Commuter Connections Regional TDM Mass Marketing program.



# Proclamation

The Car Free Day 2023 Proclamation was signed on July 19, 2023 by National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board Chair and Charles County Commissioner President, Reuben Collins, at the Metropolitan Washington Council of Governments. This was to recognize Friday, September 22, 2023, as Car Free Day throughout the Washington, DC metropolitan region.

# 2023 Proclamation

*WHEREAS,* the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board (TPB) is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Washington, DC region; and

**WHEREAS,** the TPB through its Commuter Connections program organizes and promotes the annual Car Free Day event along with its jurisdictional network members throughout the region; and

**WHEREAS,** Car Free Day invites those who live and work in the region to telework and try alternative forms of transportation such as transit, bicycling, scootering, walking, and "car-lite" methods such as carpools and vanpools; and

**WHEREAS,** Car Free Day benefits the National Capital Region through improved air quality, mobility, energy conservation, and reduced parking demands; and

**WHEREAS,** Car Free Day corresponds with the culmination of European Mobility Week's celebration of sustainable mobility from September 16-22, 2023.

*NOW THEREFORE,* be it resolved that the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board:

1. Proclaims Car Free Day throughout the Washington Metropolitan region to be observed on Friday, September 22, 2023; and

2. Encourages those who live and work in the region to take the pledge to be Car Free or car-lite at www.CarFreeMetroDC.org; and

3. Acknowledges TPB member jurisdictions who have adopted similar proclamations in support of Car Free Day 2023.

WHEREAS, Car Free Day is a worldwide event that encourages greener methods of travel; meaning ways to get around other than driving alone by car; and


WHEREAS, the National Capital Region Transportation Planning Board is the Metropolitan Planning Organization for the Washington, DC region; and



Below is a screenshot of the 2023 Car Free Day website's homepage. Analytics are as followed: users 23,386, sessions 27,121, and pageviews 45,783.




# **Social Media**

# **Clean Air Partners**

Clean Air Partners serves the metropolitan Baltimore-Washington regions by empowering individuals and organizations to take simple actions to reduce pollution and protect public health. Commuter Connections is one of Clean Air Partners' financial sponsors. # 2023 Pledge Summary

Total regionwide pledges were 5,105.

# By Jurisdiction

All COG jurisdictions participated in support of Car Free Day 2023 and generated pledges. The District of Columbia was the number one jurisdiction with 1,130 (22 %) of the total pledges, followed by Arlington County 1,006 (20%), and Montgomery County 993 (19%). Pledges in triple-digits were also generated in the following jurisdictions order: Fairfax County, Prince George's County, Loudoun County, City of Alexandria, and Prince William County.

# By Travel Mode

Participants were asked to select the travel mode(s) they would use on Car Free Day 2023, with the average number of modes per person at 2.2. The breakdown was as follows: Walk/Run 3,064 (60%), Telework 2,590 (51%), Bicycle/Scooter 2,039 (40%), Train 1,764 (35%), Bus 1,241 (24%), and Carpool/Vanpool 650 (13%).

# By Alt Mode/SOV

Participants who self-identified as typical drive alone travelers made up 1,320 (26%) of the pledges, and those normally car-free accounted for 3,785 (74%) pledges.

# By State

With 2,186 (43%), Virginia had the greatest number of pledges in 2023, followed by Maryland at 1,705 (33%), and the District of Columbia at 1,130 (22%). Other states received 84 pledges (2%) of the total.


# By Activity


Those who took the pledge in 2023 were engaged in the following activities on Car Free Day: Working 4,176 (82%), Recreation/Exercise 2,227 (44%), Shopping/Errands 1,507 (30%), Dining Out/Entertainment 1,489 (29%), Taking Classes 354 (7%), Chauffeuring Kids 465 (9%) and Other 239 (5%).

# By Work Location

The following were work locations on Car Free Day 2023: Worked From Home 2,433 (46%), Commuted to Standard Workplace 1,868 (35%), Not Working/Other 835 (16%), Co-working/Shared Workspace/Telework Center 157 (3%).
